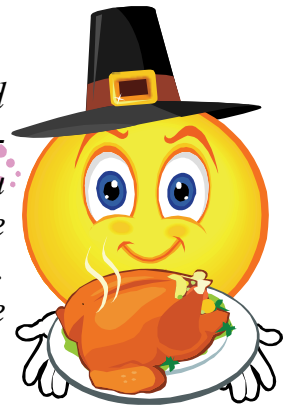




# Sunshine Family News

### WHAT SHALL I PLANT?

As each resident (**in the RV section**) returns this season and begins to spruce up your place, take a few minutes and consider what you are planting. What is that hedge or bush going to look like in a year or five years from now? Can the mower maneuver around it in the summer when you are gone? If a resident in the RV Section chooses to plant items so that the mower cannot make it around their unit, the park will not be responsible for the damage the mower causes to the plants and/or the resident may become responsible for their own lawn maintenance at their expense. It is also a big help if a landscape cloth is placed under patio blocks to prevent weeds and grass from growing up between them. On this note, please make sure all patio blocks or stepping stones are even with the ground so the mower can still cut this area.

### MAIL
